

Financial Regulation of the European Flying Disc Federation

1. Membership

- a. The EFDF recognizes two types of membership:
 1. Ordinary membership:
 - Ordinary EFDF membership is open to all national member federations of the World Flying Disc Federation (WFDF) in Europe upon applying for EFDF membership and consecutive full ratification by the Congress. The term “European territory” is defined by the Olympic Charter of the IOC.
 2. Extraordinary membership:
 - Extraordinary members are the European Flying Disc sector-specific organisations:
 - European Disc Golf Federation (EDGF) representing disc golf;
 - European Ultimate Federation (EUF) representing ultimate and indoor ultimate.

2. Membership fees

- a. Ordinary members do not pay a membership fee
- b. Extraordinary members are required to pay a yearly membership fee comprised of:
 1. A base fee of 50 €
 2. A flexible fee based on the number of participants at EFDF sanctioned medaling events of the previous year at the Elite and Masters level
 - i. The fee per participant is 0.5€
 - ii. The extraordinary members are required to inform the EFDF about the number of participants at EFDF sanctioned medaling events of the current year until Dec.1.
- c. The bill for the membership fees will be sent in the first quarter of the year.
- d. The changes to the financial regulations and fees are decided on by Congress (EFDF Statutes §10.3).

3. Action in case of non-payment

- a. Extraordinary members are required to pay their membership fees upon reception of the bill sent by EFDF. In case an extraordinary member fails to transfer the membership fee to the EFDF account the following actions can be taken:
 1. Payment reminder if payment is delayed by 2 months
 2. Late fee if the payment is delayed by 4 months. The late fee amount corresponds to the base fee.
 3. Temporary suspension of the extraordinary member’s representation in the EFDF board if payment is delayed by 6 months.

4. Date of Validity

The financial regulation was approved by Congress on <DATE>. It will come into effect on January 31st, 2024.
